July & August, 2007

Sandy and I have been from the beautiful coast of Fort Lauderdale, Florida to the Pacific Coast of Oregon. We have driven over five thousand miles and have visited churches in Springfield and Aurora MO, Dallas, Odessa and Monahans TX, Medford OR, Las Vegas NV and Albuquerque NM in just the last seven weeks.

Oh, what a joy it is to give a report of what God has done and is doing in Costa Rica. How He has allowed us to be a part of His plan in establishing churches and spreading the Gospel to the regions beyond. How families, men and women, teens and children have accepted Christ as Savior and begun to grow in God's grace and knowledge. To watch our children in the Lord begin to mature into Servants of God who can continue the works and ministries that we have started.

As we shared with you in our last letter, we have turned the church that we started in the city of Coronado over to a National Pastor. The church continues to grow weekly, souls are being saved and people are being baptized almost on a weekly basis. Last month they had a "Family Revival" that was well attended each night of the week and this month they will complete their "Faith Promise Mission" year, having reached their goal for 2006-2007 and are planning a great "Missions Conference" this next week, asking God what He would have them do this next year in their "Faith Giving" toward World Wide Missions. Sandy and I are like proud parents watching their children grow into young adults who no longer depend on mom and dad for their substance, but are thankful for the things that they have been taught to make them a success in this world.

Now, we are home for a years furlough. Our needs are many and our hearts are full of plans that God has burdened us with. We need new supporting churches to accomplish the work and ministry that God has called us to and God is already doing this. We needed to raise special funds for the Library in our Seminary and God has already answered that need. We must raise special funds to be able to purchase property when we go back to Costa Rica to begin a new work and another church in another town that God has burdened our hearts for in Costa Rica.

We have already scheduled to be in many of our supporting churches and to give a report, if you desire us to be in your church, please let us know as we make our plans for the Spring and early Summer of 2008. We have a few Sundays open in September 2007 of this year in the Dallas, Ft. Worth area that we are praying about.

Please continue to pray for our safety and health as we travel this next year. Pray that God will use us to touch young people, adults and churches about the Macedonian call to the regions beyond.
